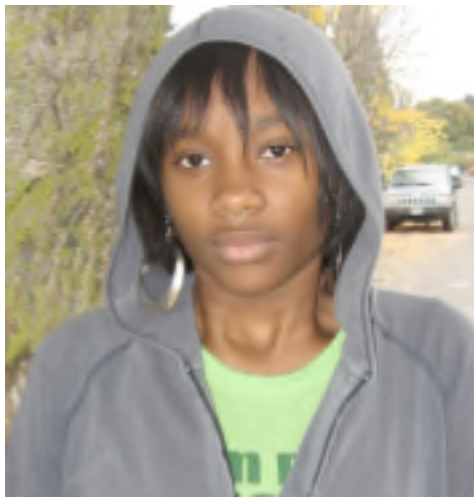




Culture of Poverty
